1. NEPTUN

Student login:

At Semmelweis University, we use the NEPTUN system to perform administrative tasks regarding your education.

As a student, you can use the system for the following purposes: (1) Check your data and information regarding your studies, (2) Register for courses/subjects, (3) Sign up for exams, (4) Check your registered results, (5) Monitor the transfers of your student benefits, (6) Inform yourselves about your payment obligations, (7) Pay your financial charges, (8) Request a student ID, (9) Register for a dormitory (10) View your assembled timetable, (11) File requests, (12) Receive messages from the administrators of the Dean's Office, Registrar's Office, departments and their educators.

You can access NEPTUN with a login code (ID) and a password which you received via e-mail upon admission.

2. SeKA

The purpose of SeKA, from the Hungarian abbreviation of Semmelweis University Central Authentication, is to allow you to only require logging into one account to access the multiple websites of the university requiring registration. A log-in system fit for everything. You will be able to use this to log into Moodle and Zoom alike. Your SeKA ID functions as an EduID as well, granting you access to useful online opportunities tied to that system as well which are worth using during your studies. 3. University e-mail address and Office 365

Students of the University are granted free access to Microsoft Office 365. This includes several services: a university e-mail, Word, Excel, OneNote, PowerPoint, OneDrive. Through OneDrive, students receive 1 TB of cloud-based storage. Using this cloud service, you can store all of your important files, documents and lectures in one place, work on them and even share them with each other.

4. Moodle

Moodle platform:

Moodle is an online educational platform, which uses course data it takes from NEPTUN. Educators have the opportunity to share learning material, publish online tests, examinations, and even send messages. Educators can start video conferences and webinars using Zoom and Big Blue Button. You can log into Moodle with your SeKA ID.

5. Eduroam

The eduroam service allows you to, using the SeKA system, without any additional permissions, freely use the Wi-Fi networks in the educational and research facilities of various countries around the globe (and, of course, within the buildings of our university). To access the service, you have to configure your mobile devices, for which you can find assistance using the following links:

The SE App is a constantly evolving application, with the goal of aggregating all of the information and sites most often used by students in one place in order to make student life easier. The app contains several useful functions, such as digital library cards and a map of the campus.

7. Student VPN access

Using your student VPN access, you can easily access the databases and journals of the university from home. To use the service, log into the website of the Central Library with your NEPTUN/SeKA ID, then click on the “Register” tab on the page about student VPN.

You can log into Zoom using SeKA, allowing you to start video chats up to 40 minutes in length. You can access the system using your SeKA credentials, by clicking Sign In.
