Ergonomic approach

- Clinical dentistry is physically demanding in some very specific ways. Backs, necks, shoulders, wrists and hands that for some reason are vulnerable to injury may be challenged by a combination of position, repetitive motion, stress, and even leisure activities.
- Comfortable doctor and patient, support staff position.
- Dental professionals may be at risk for exposure to numerous workplace hazards. These hazards include, but are not limited to, the spectrum of bloodborne pathogens, pharmaceuticals and other chemical agents, human factors, ergonomic hazards, noise, vibration, and workplace violence.
- The comfort helps and protect against (good access, Restraint, lighting).
- Low dental chair, lying position, exhausting system

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Minimal instrument

• The respective authorities regulates the dental clinic, equipment, kits and sets, minimum requirements and staffing, operation Regulation

Dental office

- At least 12 m2 (each chair 9 m2)
- Height min. 2.5 m, 2.1 m washable, disinfectable, sink area is tiled The floor is gapless, washable, disinfectable, antislide, antistatic
- Medical feucet, sink, shampoo dispenser, disinfectant dispenser, papertowel
- Washable, disinfectable furniture
- Sterilization of equipment

Instruments

Dental unit


- Dental chair (comfortable position, good acces)
- Instrument table (easy movable, easy fixed)
- Operation unit: high speed turbina, micromotor, water, air syringe
- Operation lamp (10000 lux shadowless)
- Waterblock: exhaustor (saliva suction)
- Polimerisation lamp
