- The Institute of Behavioural Sciences, Semmelweis University is inviting students to apply for paid **Teaching Assistant** position for the subject **International Mentoring Program (two semesters)**.
- Only **medical students** who served at least one academic year as a mentor and **completed the mentoring program elective course** with an excellent grade can apply.

**GRANTS AVAILABILITY:**

- **Prized Teaching Assistant (TA) place for English program: 3 students**
- **Prized TA place for German program: 1 students**

**DEADLINES AND REQUIRED TIME INVESTMENT**

- **Application submission deadline:** Last day of the 2025/2026 spring semester exam period
- **Application evaluation deadline:** Beginning of the 2026/2027 fall semester diligence period
- **TA assignment duration:** 28 academic weeks corresponding to the academic fall and spring semesters of 2026/2027
- **Required duration of monthly involvement:** Minimum of 10 hours per month

**TASKS OF THE TEACHING ASSISTANT**

- **Tasks to be performed:** Participation in the organizational, communication, and administrative duties of the International Mentoring Program (IMP) under the supervision and guidance of Board Members and Institute staff. Tasks include:
  - Supporting the **organization of program events**, workshops, lectures, and supervisions
  - Helping track and document **attendance**
  - Assisting the teachers during practice sessions, lectures and related events
  - Helping track task performance of the mentors
  - Participating in team meetings related to the program's development
  - Promoting program visibility and supporting outreach efforts
- **Conditions for signing the semester:**
  - **Attendance and active participation** in assigned duties throughout the semester, confirmed by a supervising board member or program coordinator with a certificate of
  - Adherence to the code of conduct of the International mentoring Program

- **How to obtain the semester signature and certificate of completion:**
  - Upon verification of active participation and task completion, the supervising coordinator will issue a certificate of completion. It is the responsibility of the TA to ensure timely submission of this certificate to the Institute's administrative contact.
  
- **TA scholarship amount:** Based on the current dean's decision.
  
- **Requirements of application:**
  - Prior experience as a mentor
  - Completed the mentor program elective course with an excellent grade
  - Excellent communication and organizational skills
  - Proficiency in **English** (and **German** for applicants to the German program)
  - Familiarity with basic digital tools (Google Suite: Gmail, Drive, Sheets, etc.)
  - Ability to work collaboratively with a team of board members and university staff
  
  - Completion of the forms required by Semmelweis University from all teaching assistants
