

NOTES FOR STUDENTS OF FACULTY OF PHARMACY

2019/2020

Absences: A maximum of **3 absences** from the laboratory practicals are allowed, otherwise the semester is invalid.

Midterm examinations: two times in the semester, 10 essay questions each. For acceptance, a minimum of **6 points/midterm** must be achieved. Without passing this threshold successfully, the semester is invalid.

Suggested material for learning: Textbooks: Murray, Rosenthal, Pfaller: *Medical Microbiology 6th Edition*, Mosby Elsevier (2009); Hugo and Russell's: *Pharmaceutical Microbiology*, 7th Edition (Eds.: Denyer, S.P., Hodges, N.A., Gorman, S.P.) Blackwell Science (2004). Lectures: the lecture slides will be available on the E-learning portal (<https://itc.semmelweis.hu/moodle/>).

Study competition: Single and multiple choice test with 60 questions, based on general and detailed bacteriology, presumably at the end of April. Partial exam exemption can be achieved.

Final examination: Every Tuesday and Thursday in the exam period (registration and modification is possible only through the Neptun system). A written test with 10 **minimum questions** precedes the **oral exam**, where 9 out of 10 points must be achieved, otherwise the result of the exam is failure (1). Both the minimum questions with the correct answers, and the oral exam question list will be available on the website. On the day of the exam, please come to room E19 (I. floor) between 8:15-8:30 and bring any type of photo identification (e.g., student card). In case of failure, repetition of the exam is allowed earliest on the next exam day.
