Recommended book, study material:

practices.

Midterms:

2 times, on the 6th and 11th week of the
practices.

The topic of the first midterm will be
general microbiology (lectures 1-6 and
lectures 1-6). The topic of the second
midterm will be systemic bacteriology
(lectures 7-15, and 6-10 practices). 60%-
60% is necessary to pass successfully the
midterms. The unsuccessful midterms
must be repeated within one week if is
possible.

Absences:

In accordance with the Study and
Examination Regulations

**You have to be present on 75% practices
to get signature (3 absences)!**

**Late arrival (according to the Study and
Examination Regulations):**

The students can be late max. 5 min. Three
lateness is one absence.

To get the signature:

Is based on the number of the absences
and the students must pass successfully
both midterms.

Examination:

Every week during the examination
period, on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
Registration and exam date changes
according to the Neptun programme.

Method of assessment: written exam
(Moodle test) and minimum questions with
10 minimum questions. The student will
answer the question paper before the
Moodle test exam and then complete the
Moodle test. The Moodle program will offer
to the student a mark. If the student
answers will be 9 out of the 10 questions
correctly, the grade offered by Moodle is
increased by one value and this will be
registered in Neptune. A failed Moodle
exam will not be affected by the result of
the minimum questions.

The third exam will orally. To enter the oral
exam, students must pass the written entry
test in which 20 minimal questions will be
asked, 4-4 questions each from 5 topics:
general microbiology, systemic
bacteriology, mycology, virology,
parasitology. To pass the entry test, at least
50-50% result is required at each topics.
Failing to get 50% of the answers right
results in failing the exam and will be
registered in the Neptun.

The use of study aids such as mobile
phones, smart watches is strictly forbidden
in exams. The starting time and location of
the exams will be available on Neptun.
The minimum questions with answers will
be uploaded to Moodle.
