The student satisfaction questionnaire was completed by 2/3 of the students. Despite the many feedbacks we received, we will strive to receive more student feedback in the future. We are pleased to see that we are performing above the university average in several indicators, particularly the lectures' didactic and logical nature. We will strive to keep up the good indicators.

In response to student requests, we will continue to make the lecture materials available on Moodle and update the materials as necessary. We prioritize teaching to ensure that lecturers can start their practical training in time for lectures despite the wide range of clinical work (teaching, research, therapeutic tasks).

Our feedback on specific comments on elective subjects:

We have received only a small number of questionnaires on elective subjects. We would certainly like to increase the number of student feedback in this area to obtain a more objective picture.
