New initiative:

- Establishment of an official network of international conductive institutions as internship placements for the students of András Pető Faculty and/or possible training centers for off-campus education
- Conductive institutions, conductive rehabilitation centers and conductive special schools can apply for this title
- A new opportunity to promote conductive institutions for the students of András Pető Faculty
- A stronger bond between the conductive institutions and the parent institute
- International experience for our students is part of the quality assurance of our conductor training
- Students can supported by the Pannónia scholarship program to provide for their financial needs during their time abroad
- Off-campus education can be started in hybrid form so international conductor students can complete the program from their home country



• Human resources:

- Minimum 2 conductors with a Conductive Pedagogy BA diploma by APF and minimum 3 years of professional experience
 - Mentor for students on traineeships
 - Responsible for communicating and cooperating with the András Pető Faculty
 - Has to be able to coordinate the student's task according to the requirements of the APF
 - Has to participate in a 30-hour hybrid training at the APF before the start of the internship project. Has to participate in a 15-hour training at the APF annually.

• Institutional requirements:

- Registered organization, with a legally regulated status
- Rehabilitation in groups is a baseline
- Rehabilitation is led by a conductor
- Minimum number of clients in a group is 4
- The rehabilitation is dominantly based on the principles of conductive pedagogy
- The program must include a self-service activity, with task list, and its application
- Length of programs can be different (30 minutes, a few hours, whole day intervals, residential, continuous).
- Institutions that regularly request supervision from the faculty are given preference



- Scope of treated people:
 - Children and adults eligible for Conductive Pedagogy
 - People with a predominantly limited mobility or other abilities, or a similar combination of symptoms, as a result of a central nervous system injury
 - Diagnosis based on medical diagnosis



• Equipment:

- Instruments of conductive pedagogy:
 - Pető furniture: plinth, stool, small and large ladderback-chair, parallel bars, table, mirror, wall-bar, ladder (walking), various size mats (carpet), various-sized boxes (under the feet and behind the back)
 - Special tools: ring, stick, suction bar, two-handled cup, silverware with a thick handle
 - Age-appropriate developmental toys
 - Easy-to-handle toys according to the number of children
 - Tools for visual education
 - Representation of primary colors in the equipment
 - Balls in different sizes
 - Aids available and funded by the local health care system



• Documentation:

- The institution has
 - Written documentation of the child's/adult's development (minimum case history)
 - Child/adult development plan with a description of short and long-term goals
 - A daily and weekly schedule
 - Written description of the tasks



- Principles of Conductive Pedagogy is present in the development:
 - Specially designed, integrated educational process
 - Motivation-targeted motivation-intentional and purposeful motivation to act continuously and providing tailored feedback, evaluation
 - Goal system adapted to the child's individual characteristics individualspecific development plan - embedded in a complex programme and a conductive group format
 - Emphasis on and focus on active children's activities and learning by doing, experiencing and learning
 - Complex personal development, advocating and demanding a holistic approach
 - Keeping the group as a form of organization
 - Rhythmic intending used

- Receving the title: András Pető Faculty's Designated Institute for International Practice
- Access to the detailed topics of the practice subjects
- One free participation in events organized by the András Pető Faculty for 3 guests
- 3 free copies of books and other professional publications of the András Pető Faculty

How to become part of the network

- Official request letter signed and stamped via e-mail to the petointernational@semmelweis.hu address
- Order your first supervision
 - A 5-day session by a senior conductor from András Pető Faculty
 - Checks that professional expectations are met
 - Help to complete any missing requirements
 - Write a report when all requirements are fulfilled
 - Order a professional course for at least one of your conductors (2 days Zoom and 3 days in Budapest) to become a mentor conductor
- A committee of András Pető Faculty officially grants the title for the institution for 1 year
- The title can be renewed by ordering supervision every year plus ordering a professional course for your colleagues at least once every 3 years (minimum 5 participants)
