Action plan based on student satisfactory inquiries of 2020/21 Spring term

Subjects: Periodontology II and IV

General opinion:

- Student participation in the lectures: Perio II 48,6%, Perio IV has not reached the minimum requirement
- Generally our results in Perio II are beyond the average of the Faculty points and are 4 pt+
- Our results are significantly higher than the Faculty overall average: organization, management of the practices; role of the practices within the subject in order to master the curriculum.
- 5th year students showed unconcern in the subject's evaluation.
- By the student feedbacks we managed all difficulties well during the Covid19 lockdown, furthermore they are looking forward to personally meeting again.

Plan:

- to keep on the good results and discipline
- to dedicate higher attention to the online available learning materials
- the wish for personal interaction hopefully will be fulfilled in the new semester if the Covid situation allows.

Individual student feedbacks and answers:

- some students highly appreciated the practice's quality and the teachers attitude toward them. This attitude must be kept going on.
- There were some complaints on uploaded lectures, that they are not pleasing esthetically. I personally checked the quality of many uploaded lectures and looking at them on a high resolution computer screen, the quality was more than pleasing.
- students informed us, that some long lectures miss to emphasize and/or summarize the essence of the lecture, and big amount of information without synthesis makes learning process difficult. Plan: from now on all perio lectures will include a „Conclusion” or „Summary” slide at the end of

the presentation. At the beginning of the practices the practice leaders usually gave a briefing of the lecture prior to the practice.
