Action plan based on student satisfactory inquiries of 2021/22 spring term

Subjects: Periodontology II and IV

General opinion:

- Student participation in the lectures' evaluation: Perio II 35.9%, Perio IV has not submitted any satisfactory inquiries.
- Generally, our results in Perio II are the same as the average of the Faculty's points and reached a range of 4.0- 4.43 according to the questions asked, which is considered satisfactory. The summarized average value is around 4.2-4.3 without any significant difference compared to the average Faculty's points.
- Our results are very similar than the Faculty's overall average in Perio II: the subject aroused the students interest; organization; attendance; management of the practices; role of the practices within the subject in order to master the curriculum.
- By the student feedbacks we managed all difficulties well during the Covid19 lockdown and pandemic.
- The lectures were considered to be knowledgable and evidence based.
- Reflecting for the previous years inquiries, the plan to summarize the lectures with conclusion has been successfully fulfilled. The available online materials was extended with audio files, but this has to be further improved.

Plan:

- To keep on the good results and discipline.
- To still dedicate higher attention to the online available learning materials.
- To further upkeep the students' interest toward the subject, to reach a higher number of attendance during the lectures. This is a difficult objective if the students do not show motivation in order to visit lectures. The department's medical

leadership does not support the idea of not having catalog during lectures in case of dental medical subjects.

- We have received neither suggestions nor any opinions either from Perio II or from Perio IV.
