

Instructions for the installation and settings of the CaseViewer program



For viewing the digitized sections, you need to install CaseViewer, which can be downloaded from <https://www.3dhistech.com/caseviewer>

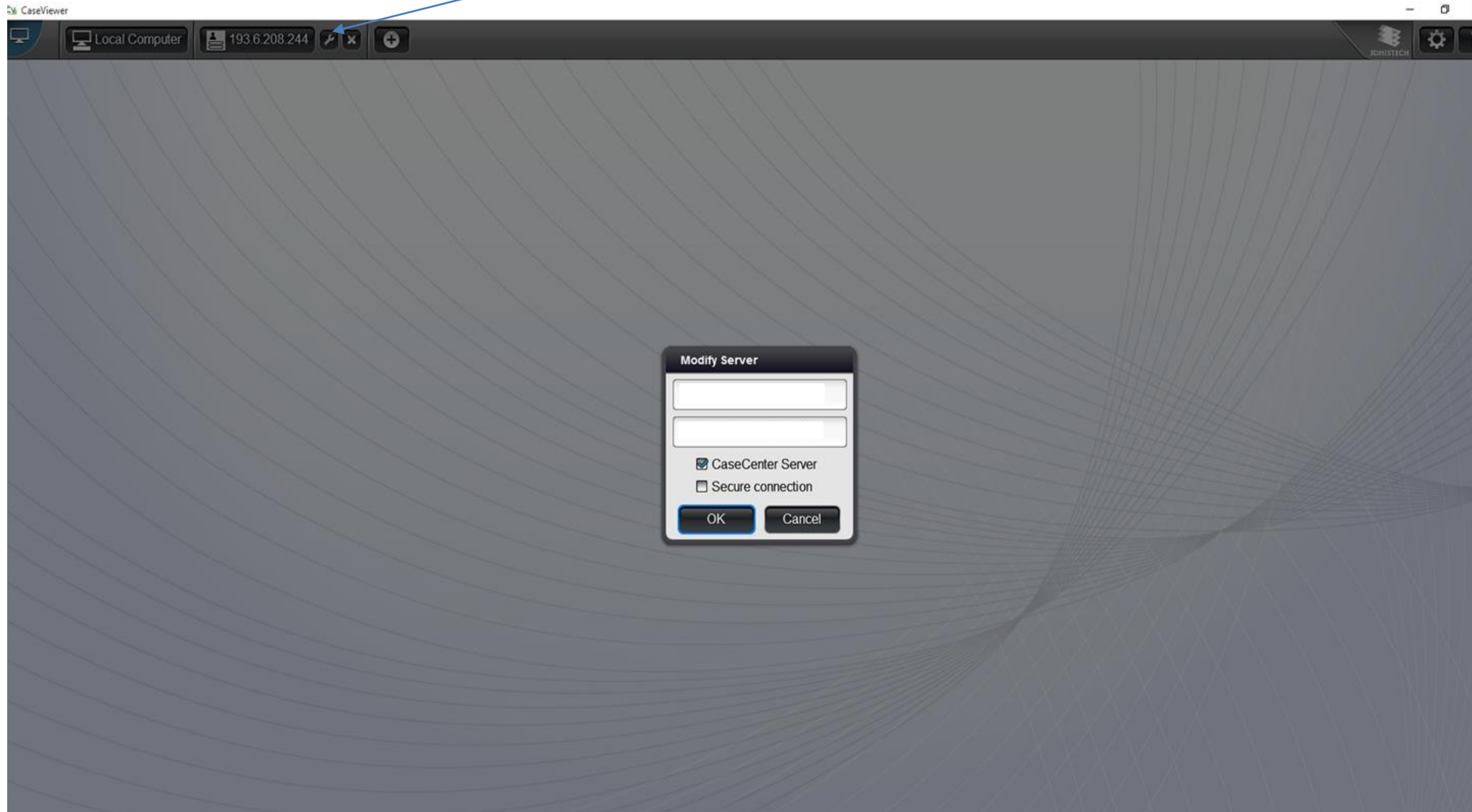
This is a free program, so license is not needed.

When you install the program, you should always click on the „next” button.



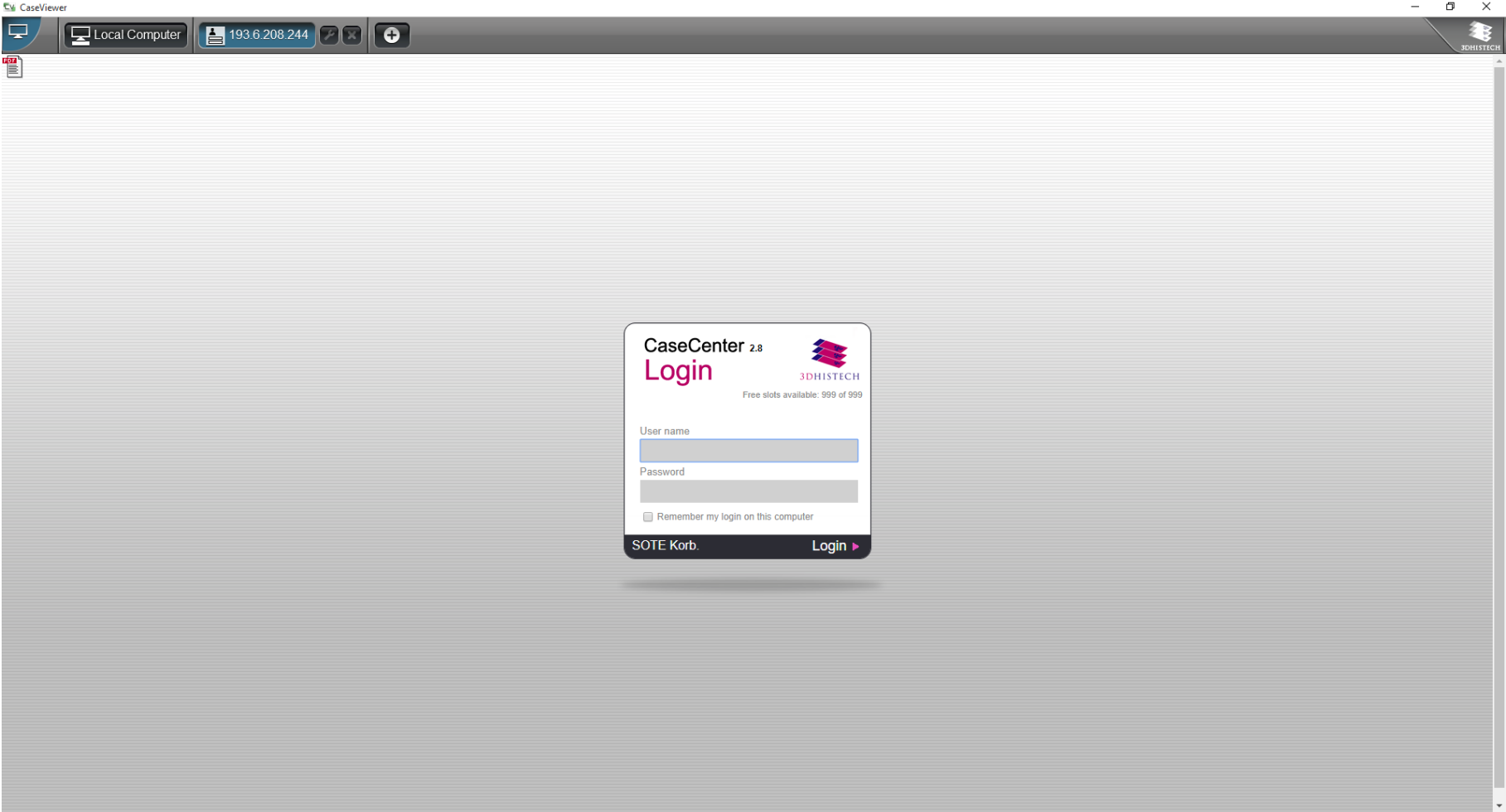
After installing do the following settings:

After starting the program, click on the following icon (monkey wrench). Write the following into both rows of the window: 193.6.208.244.



When you click on the numbers, you will see the login window. Write in the login information:

user name: tanulo password: korb1



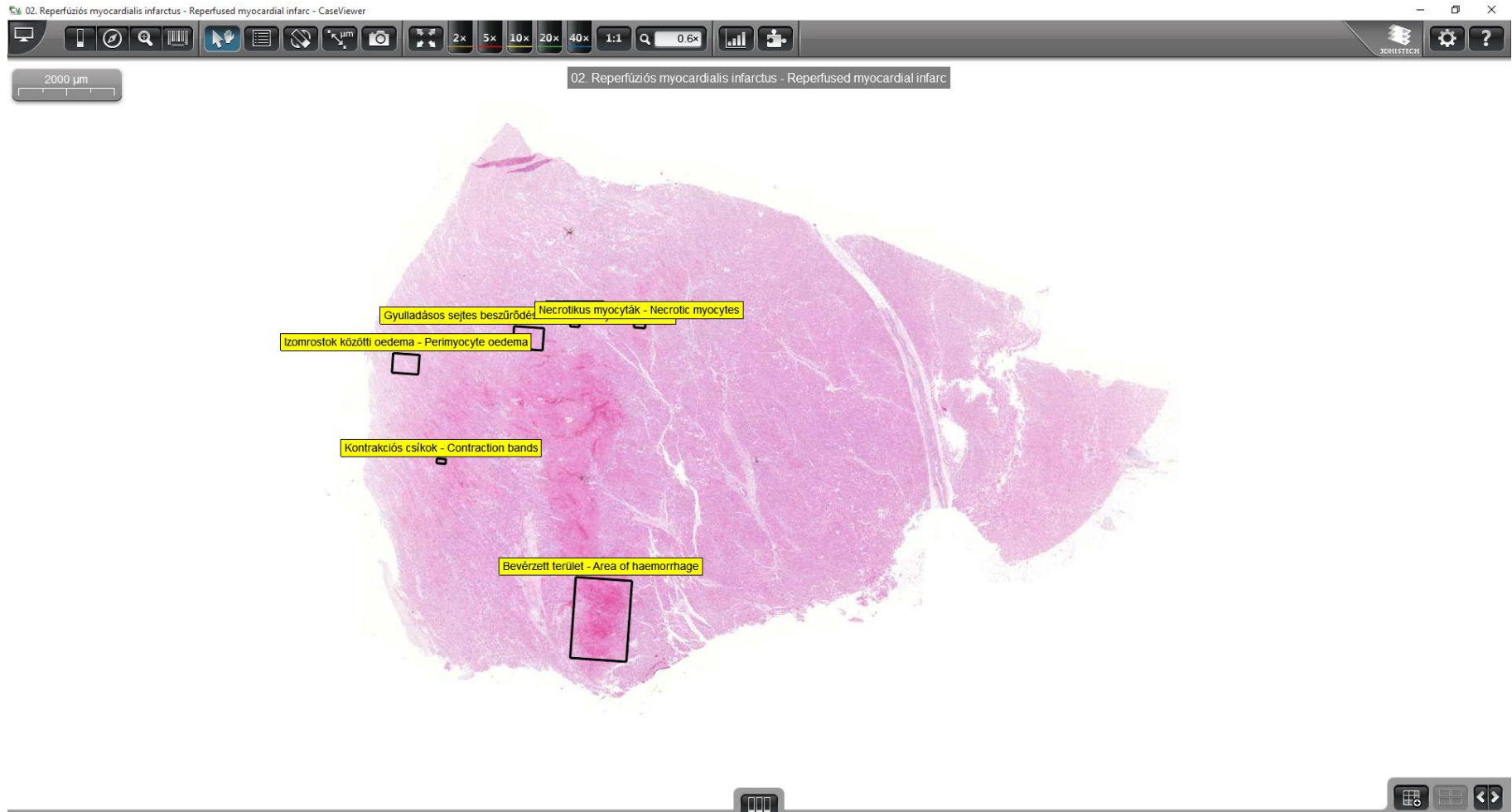
If you select a folder, you will see the sections in it.
