I. Evaluation of Scientific and Innovation Activities

Publication Scoring: $IF \times \text{Journal Reputation} \times \text{Author Contribution} / 3$

Journal Reputation Multiplier

Author Contribution

Co-author: 1 point

First, corresponding, or last author: 5 points (*divided by the number of authors with the same authorship status*)

Citation Scoring:

Independent citation received by a first-author or last-author publication: 1 point

Independent citation received by a co-authored publication: 0.5 points

International Conference Abstract

First/corresponding/last author: 3 points (*in case of shared authorship, divided by the number of authors sharing that status*)

Co-author: 1 point

OTDK Award Placement (National Scientific Students' Associations Conference)

Pro Scientia Award: 30 points

1st Prize: 10 points

2nd Prize: 5 points

Special Prize / Commendation: 3 points

Documented **innovation** output (e.g., patent, utility model protection, software, institutional/official disclosure of know-how, etc.): up to 30 points per intellectual property asset.

II. Employment relationship or other work-related legal relationship with the University, or with an institution or company that has a cooperation agreement with the University (e.g., healthcare service employment or residency status)

- Employment or other legal relationship with the University: 20 points
- Employment or other legal relationship with an institution or company that has a cooperation agreement with the University: 10 points
