# Action plan based on the student feedback received in the I. semester of the 2023/2024 academic year.

**Department: Department of General Dental Preclinical Practice**  
**Faculty: Faculty of Dentistry**

According to the data from the subject surveys, the questionnaire for the lecture was completed by 60 of the 77 students, of which 2 were unfilled. The practical questionnaire received 338, of which 196 were unfilled, resulting in 142 evaluable questionnaires, double the number for the year.

## Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("implementation review"):

Last year, our students requested the course materials to be made available online. This semester we have made available the ppt and Kaltura recordings of the lectures, as well as the video and ppt materials for the practices. Compared to last year's indicators, our practical training received a more positive evaluation, with students admitting to a lower participation rate in the lectures, which implies that the lecture material was perceived as less logical.

## Our feedback on general comments by the students:

### Comments on presentations:

- The content of the course lacks focus. I suppose it is an introductory course to dentistry, and it would be fine with a wide scope of dental disciplines, such as paedodontics, orthodontics. The challenge of the course is that it presented tons of information to students with no prior knowledge.

During the 14 weeks of the curriculum, we had been dealing with the topic of paediatric dentistry in both practice and lectures.

- This is the first practice for our dental students, and it has been very interesting and helpful. The professors were kind and attentive, and I hope to pass the exam with them. I also want to learn from professors next semester. Thank you very much.

There were 12 reviews for the leaders of this course, of which only 5 were meaningful.
