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FIRE AND JOB SECURITY RULES FOR STUDENTS

all the three Skill labs

- > You must arrive on time both theoretical and practical sessions in a condition suitable for their duties, in terms of both health and attire.
- > Students must maintain a clean, well-groomed, and professional appearance, wearing attire that is appropriate for their future medical profession and does not pose any health or safety risks. Short clothing and long nails are not permitted.
- ➤ Watches, rings, necklaces, bracelets, and any other jewelry that could pose a direct safety hazard may not be worn in work areas where they could interfere with safe practice.
- > Any accident, illness, or injury related to practical training must be reported immediately to the instructor or supervisor.
- > You are required to properly wear and use the provided personal protective equipment and ensure its cleanliness as expected.
- > You are financially responsible for the tools provided for practice and must cover the cost of any damage to them.
- > You must check capital equipment, engine, furnishment for security and use in function. You must report any damage, failure in function, lack of functionality, technical problem or missing element from your work station
- ➤ Work may only be carried out with tools, equipment, instruments, aids, personal protective equipment, and safety gear that are in perfect working condition.
- > You can only carry out any kind of labour process, practice or use labor equipments under supervision.
- > You must arrive well-groomed and on time to the practice as expected from a medical student. Your medical gown must be white, clean and fully buttoned. If you have long hair, it must be tied back.
- > At the end of each class you must leave your work station clean and tidy.
- You must turn off the gas and remove any kind of flammable thing from your work station.
- You are required to maintain the expected level of order, discipline, and cleanliness, focusing on their tasks and completing their tasks. If you notice any hazardous conditions during their work (based on your professional knowledge and abilities), you must either resolve the issue or report it to the instructor or supervisor for further action.
- > When leaving the work area, you must ensure that no fire hazards remain in the area.

We would like to remind students to be especially attentive when using alcohol burners. Always put the alcohol burner cap back after use.
