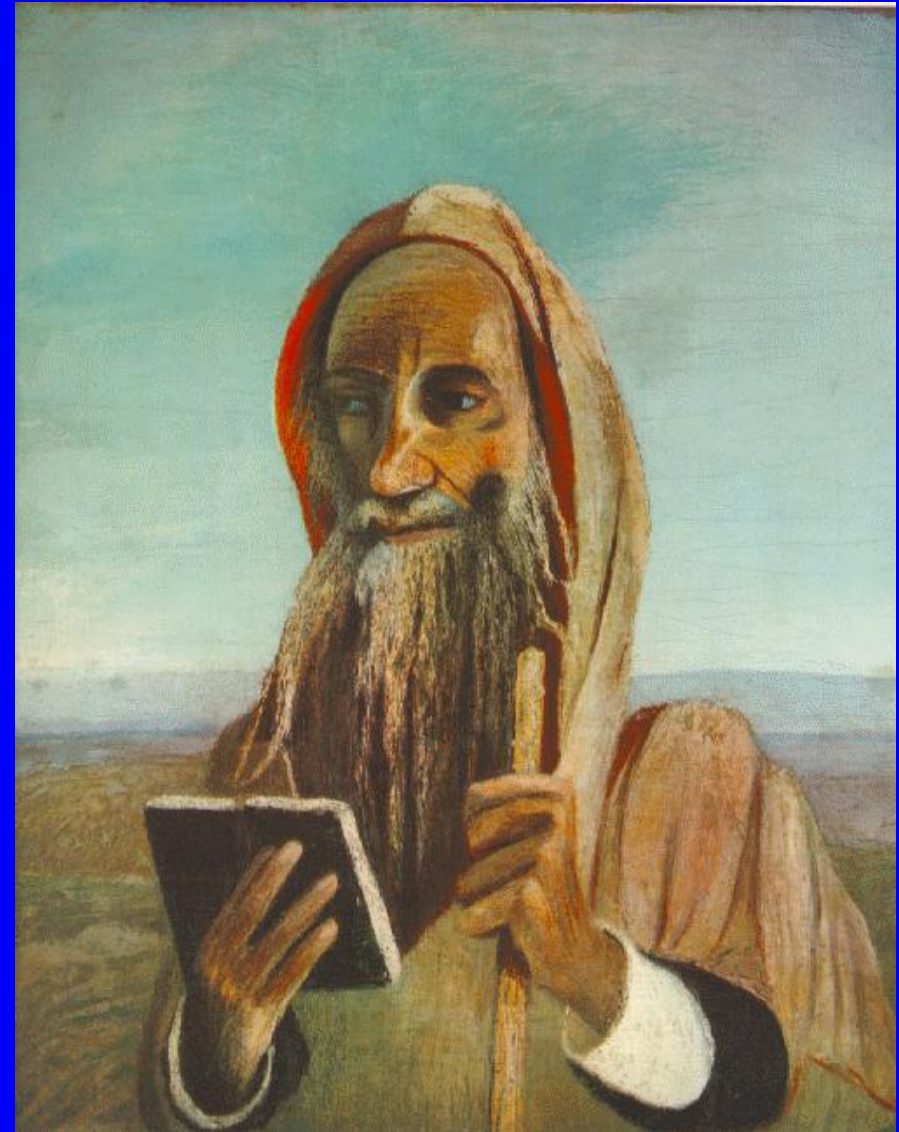

DSM IV TR

- Disorders in childhood and adolescence
- Delirium, dementia and other cognitive dis.
- Mental disorders due to general med. cond.
- Substance related disorders
- Schizophrenia and other psychotic disorders
- Mood disorders
- Anxiety disorders

- Somatoform disorders
- Factitious disorders
- Dissociative disorders
- Sexual disorders
- Eating disorders
- Sleep disorders
- Adjustment disorders



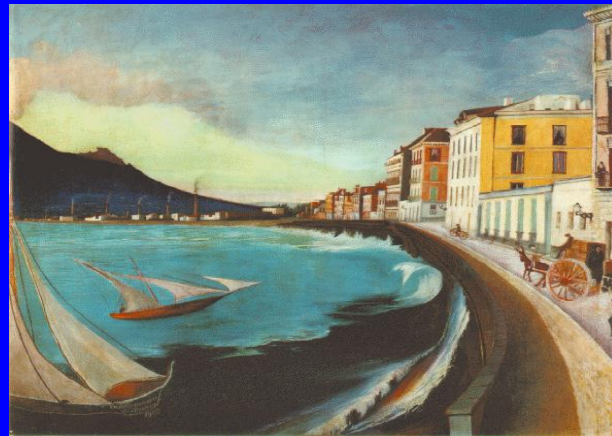
Etiology in psychiatry

- anamnesis (history)
- examination (psychiatric examination)



- interview (mental status examination)
