

Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 1. semester of the 2022/2023. academic year

Department: Department of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy

Faculty: Faculty of Dentistry

Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("*implementation review*"):

Based on the previous student feedback evaluation we were not concerning major changes in the structure of the course. Based on the positive feedbacks by the students for patient presentations we were planning to include more occasions into the course, this was successful in the case also of some lectures. Students were generally satisfied with special actions dealing with COVID pandemics. This year however was no need for that.

Our feedback on general comments by the students:

In general we received satisfactory feedbacks from the students for the subject. Scores given for certain aspects of the course were within the average of the semester. Comments by the students show that they are satisfied with the general structure and organisation of lectures and patient presentations. Concerning the positive feedbacks we do not plan major changes in structure of the course.

Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:

Lectures got positive comments from the students and this is an important feedback for us, as lectures are in the focus of the structure of the whole course. We received one specific comment, about students being satisfied with meeting patients who have the diseases and symptoms presented in the lectures. They found it easier to study and memorize the materials in this way. Based on the positive feedbacks we keep focusing on the patient presentations. Another remark included the students difficulties of finding the relevance of this course to dentistry students. For that reason we plan to emphasise the importance of certain psychiatric conditions in dentistry even further. Online tuition materials were found to be helpful for the students. Students also found the requirements for the exam clear and well organized.
