Course description:

The Dental laboratory summer practice is 2 weeks (60 hours).

The aim of the summer practice is to acquire knowledge of odontotechnology and to acquire basic practical and theoretical knowledge, to develop manual dexterity.

The summer practice includes a visit to the laboratory, where the student will acquire a working knowledge of the laboratory stages and of the preparation of fixed and removable prostheses. During the practice, the student will be required to independently perform: preparation of a sample, preparation of a wax pattern of an incisor and a small reamer, and preparation of a wax chewing surface pattern (lower and upper small reamers and large reamers). **The student must be able to present the wax patterns to the Department if required.**

Method and type of assessment:

The practice must be evaluated on a 3-grade scale according to the following: excellent, satisfactory, failed

The rating should be based on the student's theoretical knowledge and practical work, as well as his or her relationship with patients.
