d) for terminology courses: average of 4.5 or higher in or Medical and Specialist Terminology; advantage: high placement or >80% result in Latin/Terminology competitions;

e) high-level familiarity with the relevant language for modern languages; for terminology: solid knowledge of anatomy, clinical, and prescription vocabulary;

f) exemplary behavior and an active, enthusiastic attitude towards community life.

Suggested content of the motivation letter: experience related to medical language (e.g., clinical practice, volunteer work, international exchange, Profex exam, Latin/Terminology competition placement), and your reasons for applying as a demonstrator.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for a personal interview in **mid-July**. The date will be arranged via email.

Suitability assessments will be conducted by instructors of the Institute, and applicants will be notified of the decision by the **end of July** at the latest.

The final decision on appointments lies with the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine. Results will be announced at the **beginning of September**.
