

**Application for Teaching Assistant Scholarship
at the Institute of Biophysics and Radiobiology**

The Institute of Biophysics and Radiation Biology invites applications from students for the academic year 2024/25.

Aim of the scholarship:

The aim of the employment of a TA is to involve suitable and deserving students in the teaching and scientific research work of the Institute of Biophysics and Radiation Biology, in addition to their more intensive and higher quality professional training, in order to prepare and educate the next generation of teachers and researchers. The Tas will be employed for 20 hours per month during the academic semesters I and II of the academic year 2023/24.

Application requirements:

Applicants for a demonstrator assignment are

- a) a student in his/her second or higher year who
- b) has achieved at least a good academic average in the previous academic year,
- c) has passed an examination in biophysics with distinction (excellent or good),
- d) has an exemplary conduct,
- (e) have above-average expression and knowledge of foreign languages,
- (f) a commitment to contribute to the teaching of biophysics.

The tasks to be carried out by the TA

- 1) Participate in the preparation of practical sessions (e.g.: checking the operation of experimental equipment, calibration, preparation of test samples),
- 2) assisting the instructor in the practical lesson,
- 3) participate in the technical preparation of presentations (presentations, preparation of illustrative material), if required,
- 4) assisting in lectures or exercises,
- 5) assisting in the organisation and running of any demonstrations or competitions,
- 6) contributing to the development and introduction of new practical teaching and research methods,
- 7) to submit a detailed report on his/her activities to the Director of the Institute by the last day of the spring term.

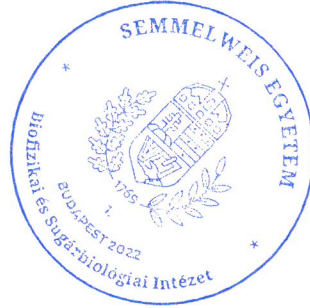

You can apply by filling in the form of application which can be found at the website of the Department of Biophysics and Radiation Biology

Application deadline: 5 July 2024.
