Subject: credit transfer register of equivalence

DECISION

In the academic year 2024, the students of the Faculty of Dentistry of Semmelweis University (hereinafter referred to as students) shall complete their studies in accordance with the curriculum of the academic year 2021/22. Based on their curricula of the academic years 2008/2009, 2011/12, 2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16, 2017/18, 2019/20, 2020/21 (hereinafter: previous curricula) as well as the curriculum of the academic year 2021/22, the credits of the indicated compulsory and optional subjects shall be recognized pursuant to the equivalence register approved in the decision No. 59116-3/FOFTO/2024 of the Credit Transfer Committee, in all three of the languages of the programs (Annex 1 - Hungarian equivalency table, Annex 2 - English equivalence table, Annex 3 - German equivalence table).

As stated above, the following section will be added to the Diploma/Diploma Supplement/Diploma Registration and Transfer Document and Diploma Supplement of students graduating in the academic year 2024:

“The compulsory and elective subjects of the curricula of the academic years 2008/2009, 2011/12, 2013/14, 2014/15, 2015/16, 2017/18, 2019/20, and 2020/21 shall be recognized in accordance with the model curriculum of the academic year 2021/22.

The equivalence list of compulsory and optional subjects of the previous and the 2021/22 curricula is contained in Annexes 1-2-3 of this Decision (59116-4/FOFTO/2024) of the Examination and Studies Committee of Semmelweis University.”

An application for legal remedy with suspensive effect against the present decision may be submitted within 15 days of the date of notification in accordance with Articles 3 and 4 of Chapter III.7 of Semmelweis University Organisational and Operational Regulations (hereinafter: SzMSz). The appeal may be submitted to the Review Committee through the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Dentistry.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

I.

In the academic year 2024, the fifth-year students of the Faculty of Dentistry of Semmelweis University shall complete their studies in accordance with the curriculum of the academic year 2021/22. The credits of the compulsory and optional subjects completed in the previous years shall be recognized in accordance with the curriculum of the academic year 2021/22 pursuant to the equivalence register (Annexes 1-2-3)

II.

This decision is based on the provisions of Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education and the following provisions of the Student Requirements System of the Semmelweis University Organisational and Operational Regulations.

Paragraph (5) of Article 49 of Act CCIV of 2011 on National Higher Education (hereinafter: Nftv.):
„Credits shall not be awarded for a given learning outcome more than once. Credits shall be recognised only after a comparison of the learning outcomes forming the basis of the credits gained, based on the outcome requirements of the courses (modules) concerned. Credits shall be recognised if there is a seventy-five percent or closer match between the learning outcomes compared. The comparison of learning outcomes shall be carried out by a committee set up for that purpose (hereinafter referred to as “credit transfer committee”) by the higher education institution.”

Article 7 (3) of PART III. Student Standards - CHAPTER III.2. Study and Examination Regulations of Semmelweis University Organisational and Operational Rules (hereinafter: SzMSz):

“In the case of a curriculum change, the correspondence of subjects in the old and the new curricula may also be recorded in an equivalence table by the person approving of the curriculum.”

Article 44 (1) Chapter III.2 of SzMSz:

(1) During credit transfer, for any passed course, completion of a course shall be recognized if the correspondence (match) is at least 75%. If the correspondence is less than 75%, the Credit Transfer Committee may approve recognition after considering the circumstances, in particular, the role of the course in achieving the training objectives and may also request the opinion of the program director. In accordance with the nature of credit transfer, the educational-research unit shall recommend the same decision for students presenting the same circumstances.


Article 44 (16)-(17) Chapter III.2 of SzMSz:

(16) “Faculties may keep a credit transfer equivalence register for their courses, driven by content, in which they may provide students with preliminary information on the equivalence of courses already recognized in previous procedures indicating data such as the date and name of a course, the higher education institution or other relevant data. When considering courses included in the register on the basis of a previous decision, provided that the course syllabus concerned remains unchanged, the Credit Transfer Committee may also follow a **simplified procedure**, thus waiving the need to consult the course coordinator or to attach the course syllabus; however, previous decisions shall not be binding.

(17) A simplified procedure may also be applied where credit transfer is between the old and the new syllabuses of the same course and an equivalence table is created with or after the change in curriculum.

The authority and the competence of the Examination and Studies Committee are specified in Article 3 (8) Chapter III.2 of SzMSz.
