## Call for Applications for a Teaching Assistant Scholarship at the Department of Biophysics and Radiation Biology

The Institute of Biophysics and Radiation Biology invites applications from students of the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Dentistry for teaching assistant positions for the 2026/27 academic year.

The aim of the TA program is to involve talented and dedicated students in the educational and scientific research activities of the Institute of Biophysics and Radiation Biology. In addition to providing more intensive and advanced professional training, the program seeks to support the development of future academic and research staff.

### Eligibility criteria:

Applicants for a TA appointment must:

- a) be a second-year or higher-level student;
- b) have achieved a minimum GPA of 3.51 (good) during the previous academic year;
- c) have successfully completed the final examination in Biophysics with an excellent grade);
- d) demonstrate a commitment to contributing to the teaching of biophysics.

### Responsibilities of the TA:

1. Participate in the preparation of practical classes (e.g., checking and calibrating experimental equipment, preparing samples for laboratory investigations);
2. Assist instructors during practical teaching sessions;
3. Contribute to the organization and implementation of demonstrations, competitions, and other academic events as required;
4. Submit a detailed report on their activities to the Director of the Institute by the last day of the spring semester teaching period.

### Regulations governing the scholarship:

The detailed regulations concerning the demonstrator scholarship are set out in the Organizational and Operational Regulations of Semmelweis University – Book III: Student Requirements System – Part III.4: Fees and Allowances Regulations (Sections 20/A–20/D).

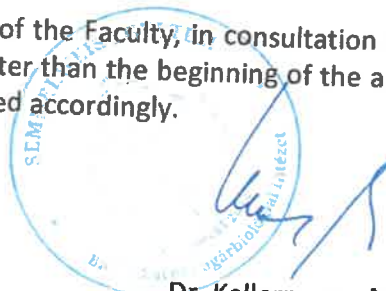
### Application procedure

Applications must be submitted using the official application form of the respective faculty. Completed application forms, signed by hand, must be submitted in hard copy to the Department of Biophysics (EOK Building 1st Floor, Room 1.202)  
(Course title to be indicated on the form: for medicine: Medical Biophysics I and II., for dentistry: Biophysics I and II.)

**Application deadline:** 10. July 2026

Applications will be evaluated by the Head of the Faculty, in consultation with the Faculty Student Union. Decisions will be made no later than the beginning of the autumn semester teaching period, and applicants will be notified accordingly.
