# Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 1st semester of the 2024/2025 academic year



#### Our feedback on general comments by the students

#### Students said:

"things are not explained well or even ever explained in the lecture. we read the textbook, but it didn't really help as no detailed or clear explanations/descriptions were given. the sources we study are lectures and textbooks, but we can rarely find a better way to clarify things. some of the midterm questions are not even talked in lectures/ explained in textbook."

"The only thing we learnt this semester is how to do lots of demonstrations. no real teaching in practices, no explanations. It was very different during previous 2 years."


"Some of the lecturers were great at delivering new knowledge, unfortunately others lacked sufficient confidence in their English skills to explain new - to us - very complex topics such as neck dissections and the different surgical approaches to H&N tumour treatment which I thought was a big shame."
