Objectives of the subject, its place in the medical curriculum:

Medical Terminology is a course designed for medical students to ease their everyday studies by providing them with linguistic and terminological knowledge. The material is closely built on the terminology of Anatomy and the clinical terminology of the Musculoskeletal system.

Requirements for participation in classes and the possibility to make up for absences:
