Topics of the course	
1. week	Repetition, conversations (important verbs, questioning pronouns)
2. week	Expression of ownership in Hungarian language; body parts. Adjectives: healthy, sick, weak, having a cold (“náthás”), having fever (“lázás”) Verbs: to cough, sneeze, stay, examine, take
3. week	At the pharmacy 1.
4. week	At the pharmacy 2. Since when? (“Mióta?”), How long? (“Mennyi ideje?”)
5. week	Medical record (Internal Medicine) 1. (patient records, family history, social history) Past tense
6. week	Medical record (Internal Medicine) 2. (medications, allergies, surgeries, present complaints) speech understanding: coherent, longer text narrated in singular 3 rd person.
7. week	Summary, 1st written test
8. week	Introduction to dental vocabulary, terms for teeth. Which tooth hurts? Where exactly does it hurt?
9. week	Questions about pain 1., practice (pronunciation, grammatical explanations)
10. week	Questions about pain 2, practice (pronunciation, grammatical explanations)
11. week	Questions about pain 3., practice (discussing possible answers, practicing listening skill, targeted questions)
12. week	Reading and discussing a sample dialogue Incomplete dialogue: writing or saying the dentist's sentences based upon the answers of the patient and writing or saying the patient's sentences based on the dentist's questions. Case history-taking (questions of the medical record→complaint, pain)
13. week	Summary, 2nd written test

14. week	Oral test
<p>Requirements for attending the course and catching-up opportunities: Attendance of lessons is obligatory. Students are allowed to have maximum 7 absences a semester. In case of more absences, the teacher may deny giving the signature. Students who miss a class, can make up for it (max. two times a semester).</p>	
<p>Possibilities to justify absence: A medical certificate is required if the student has been absent more than 7 times.</p>	
<p>Midterms tests and possibilities for retake: Two written tests and an oral test during the study period Topics of midterms: see the topics of the course. Students who fail the midterm test must retake it.</p>	
<p>Requirements for signature: Attendance of lessons is obligatory. Students are allowed to have maximum 7 absences a semester. In case of more absences, the teacher may deny giving the signature. Students who miss a class, can make up for it (max. two times a semester). Students have to pass the two midterms and the oral test.</p>	
<p>Determination of the final grade: The evaluation of student performance is based on the marks for the 2 written test, the oral test as well as the active participation in classes. For the oral examination two teachers evaluate separately the grade of the student. 0–50% = 1 (unsatisfactory) 51–60% = 2 (satisfactory) 61–75% = 3 (average) 76–89% = 4 (good) 90–100% = 5 (excellent)</p>
