Topics of the course:	
1. week	Revision: Final topics covered in previous semesters, sentences required by the Faculty of Dentistry
2. week	Prosthodontics, taking dental impression

6. week	Tooth decay
7. week	Filling, filling replacement
8. week	1st test, Case reports based on clinical practice

Requirements for attending the course and catching-up opportunities: Attendance of lessons is obligatory. Students are allowed to have maximum 7 absences a semester. In case of more absences, the teacher may deny giving the signature. Students who miss a class, can make up for it (max. two times a semester).	
Possibilities to justify absence: A medical certificate is required if the student has been absent more than 7 times.	
Midterms tests and possibilities for retake: Final examination during the exam period: listening test, written exam and oral interview Students take part in a sample final exam, the results of which are not evaluated. Topics of midterms: see the topics of the course. Students who fail the test must retake it.	
Requirements for signature:	

Attendance of lessons is obligatory. Students are allowed to have maximum 7 absences a semester. In case of more absences, the teacher may deny giving the signature. Students who miss a class, can make up for it (max. two times a semester). Students have to pass the two midterms and the oral test.

Determination of the final grade:

Final exam consisting of a listening test, written exam and oral interview, 51% is required in each part of the exam to pass.

The final grade is calculated from the average of the grades achieved in the written and the oral part of the final exam. Students have to pass both parts. The oral competencies are assessed by two examiners separately and the grade is based on the average of the scores awarded by the two examiners.

Grades:

0–50% = 1 (unsatisfactory)

51–60% = 2 (satisfactory)

61–75% = 3 (average)

76–89% = 4 (good)

90–100% = 5 (excellent)

Type of exam: final (exam)

Application for the exam: students can apply for the final via Neptun system

Modification of the application for the exam: via Neptun system according to the regulations of the faculty and the university.

Justification of absence from the exam: In case of absence from the exam, the provision of study and examination rules („Study and Examination Regulations”) are to be regarded as the guideline.
