- The chosen language of the exam is independent of the language of the state-accredited B2 language exam which is also criterion.

- Exemption from the University Professional Exam is only possible in case candidates have passed a professional language exam accredited on a state or international level.

- the Department of Languages for Specific Purposes is responsible for exemptions
