<p>Aims of the course:</p> <p>The aim of the course is to prepare students to interpret Latin diagnoses and clinical documentation of various fields of study. In particular, by teaching the authentic anatomical and clinical terminology of various body systems (mainly neurology, neonatology and pediatrics, partially pulmonology, cardiology and gastroenterology) from a practical point of view (by using excerpts of discharge summaries, outpatient records, examination findings), we provide students with a deeper knowledge of medical terminology to communicate effectively with medical professionals and patients.</p>
