<p>Aims of the course:</p> <p>The aim of this course is to prepare students for the interpretation of Latin medical diagnoses of the musculoskeletal disorders and their clinical documentation. By teaching the authentic anatomical and clinical terminology of the musculoskeletal system from a practical point of view (by using excerpts of discharge summaries, outpatient records, examination findings), we promote the competent involvement of students in the therapeutic practice, and provide them with the knowledge of medical terminology to communicate effectively with patients and their families</p>		
<p>Main content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - basic terminology of effective communication between medical professionals and between medical professionals and patients, intentional use of medical terms and Latin pronunciation in Hungary - terminology of osteology and arthrology: bones and articulations of the upper limb and pectoral girdle; bones and articulations of pelvis and lower limb; bones and articulations of vertebral column; - terminology of myology: muscles of the upper members and pectoral girdle; muscles of pelvis and lower limb; muscles of vertebral column; muscles of abdomen; - terminology of musculoskeletal disorders and clinical documentation (outpatient medical records and discharge summaries) - terms expressing condition and cause in Latin diagnoses - expressing secondary diseases and complications in Latin diagnoses, expression of localization in imaging findings
