Planned Measures based on student feedback on the spring semester of the 2022/2023 academic year – Faculty of Medicine Semmelweis Unit: Department of Languages for Specific Purposes

1. Terminology of Clinical Specialties AOVN915_1A

Only a third, 37 students out of 113, submitted the questionnaire, still we have had positive informal feedback from the students. They are satisfied with both the teachers and the subject material. Last semester already showed an improvement compared to the previous semesters, though the score was still below the faculty average. This positive tendency seems to continue, as this time the subject average score was 0.12 above the average faculty score.

The only student opinion we have in written form is:

120 out of 330 students submitted the questionnaire. The scores exceed the faculty average by 0.09 points.

A strong foundation in grammar would enable better integration with the Hungarian culture and flexibility in physician patient interactions. I think this would be greatly beneficial to the Medical Hungarian curriculum. I'm planning on pursuing private Hungarian language classes to supplement this curriculum because I would like to expand my language capabilities.

133 out of 338 students submitted the questionnaire. The subject score is the same as the faculty average: 4,63.
