Proficiency Exam

The exam takes place at the **end of the first semester**.

In the 1st semester, there are two preparatory courses for the exam; however, the grade you get there does not automatically guarantee anything in the exam.

The exam consists of a **written and a spoken part** and Students need to register for it on Neptun.

The language level of the exam is C1 (CEFR).

WRITTEN PART (60 minutes)

Number of items: 50 items / points

Total score / written part: 50 points

Task types to expect (focus on grammar):

- gap-filling - 15 points
- paraphrasing a text - 35 points

Topics to expect: topics within biomedicine

SPEAKING (15 minutes)

Total score: 50 points

Task types to expect (one of them):

1. Data commentary – 25 points
 - summarizing data presented on a graph
 - summarizing data presented in a figure
 - summarizing data presented in a chart
 - summarizing data presented in a diagram
2. Argumentation - 25 points
 - Expressing opinions and arguments

Based on:

 - i. Photos
 - ii. infographics

Topics to expects: topics within biomedicine
