

# Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 1st semester of the 2024/25 academic year

## Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("*implementation review*"):

As we promised, we rescheduled more morning practice classes for both 5th and 6th semesters. Although as we provided more interactive practice with the students, furthermore we presents on moodle video presentations and consultations. We have presented on moodle the topic list for the exam - as soon as we can in each semester.

## Our feedback on general comments by the students:

In the 2024/25 1<sup>st</sup> semester curriculum covers the compulsory English course of Translation of Medicine - Pathophysiology I. The questionnaire was submitted by 53,68% and 55,79% of 155 students for questions about the practical lessons and lectures, respectively. Based on the scores the results were the same Faculty practice average (T-test: ns) and the Faculty general average (T-test: ns).

According to the questionnaire, some students disapproved the following areas: the long practice (150 min.), and two (!) students felt boring on the practice, one student prefer morning hours for the practice. The remaining 9 comments are highly positive for the general comments of the Department.

## Area to strengthen:

We wish to improve the student-teacher ratio max. 18:1 during the practice: Our department Teaching Assistant (TA) students participates on practical courses.

We highly recommend the use of the approved textbook: Gary D. Hammer, Stephen J. Mc Phee: Pathophysiology of Disease: An Introduction to Clinical Medicine (Lange Medical Books) 7th Edition.

## Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:

- We will continue the two-course competition that provide students to gain exam exemptions.
- We will discuss with each/all teachers to manage the students points and/or requests.
- We thank you for the remainig 15 comments which are highly positive for practical lessons and tutors.
