Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 1st semester of the 2022/2023 academic year

Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("implementation review"):
Based on the comments, suggestions and feedback received from students of the previous 2021/2022
academic years action plan, we implemented the following changes:

- Students asked for more opportunity to observe operations, therefor we divided the groups into even smaller groups, so that smaller groups of students can join surgery without risking sterility.
- 2. Previously, students asked for more practical classes, therefor we tried to show more patients, surgeries, x-rays and follow-up examinations.
- 3. Students asked that the practices be more hands on, so we had the subgroups of students spend more time in the emergency room, in order for them to experience more patient care.

Our feedback on general comments by the students:

The Traumatology Department did not receive any student feedback from English language students in the 1st semester of the 2022/2023 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system.

During the course of the semester, the Traumatology Department did however conduct an immediate feedback QR-code questionnaire on practical lessons, seminars, feedback of the subject and feedback concerning the block schedule, where we received written comments from students.

There were no comments concerning the lectures/seminars, nor concerning general feedback of the subject

Comments concerning the practices or tutors:

It would be great if the practices were actually more interactive, like us doing things, at least we should get the chance to go into the OR, doing casts training and other really interesting stuff.

Needs to be longer! Practices were the best part!

Thank you for the positive comments. In the future, we will however try to teach Traumatology at both the Manninger Jenő's National Institute of Traumatology as well as at Uzsoki Hospital's Department of the Orthopedics and Traumatology, so that students can participate in more interactive practices while mastering the fundamental knowledge at seminars taught by the specialists of that field.

Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:







The Traumatology Department received 15 completed student questionnaires from the English language students in the 1st semester of the 2022/2023 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system concerning feedback of the subject, and one incomplete questionnaire. All of the feedback was in conjunction with the faculty average, except in one case, where the students were asked in what ratio did they participate in lectures of the subject. A significantly higher proportion of students participated in the subject's lectures compared to that of the average of the Faculty of Medicine of Semmelweis University.

In regards to the special questionnaire pertaining feedback on the block schedule, the Traumatology Department received 14 completed student questionnaires from the English language students in the 1st semester of the 2022/2023 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system, and one incomplete questionnaire. All of the feedback was in conjunction with the faculty average, except in one case, where the students were asked if they had enough chance to participate in patient examination, where our department received a lower score than the average of the faculty.
