Place of application:

- Semmelweis University Clinic for Traumatology
- 1083 Budapest, Korányi Sándor u. 2.
- Please go to the Triage desk on the ground floor (the tutor will go there too).

Time of application:

- On the first workday of practice, given by the University at 8:15AM

Required documents:

- Student status certificate or student ID card.
- Valid medical booklets/Occupational health certificate from within 1 year in hungarian
- **The practice can be started only by presenting the original health booklet, filled out with the student's details, which includes a valid health clearance certificate. We cannot accept a scanned copy of the booklet, or chest x-ray, blood test results.**
- Without presenting a health booklet, you can only make up for the practice, if there is available capacity at the Clinic.

Practice details:

- Bring your own **work clothes, shoes, and name tag** (wearing it is mandatory during the practice).
- From the second day the practice starts at 8:15, when you will have to meet with your assigned tutor.
- Fill out the attendance sheet every day, you will have to do 40 hours, according to instructions of the tutor.
- You will also participate in **control activities**, meaning on their **control day** you will meet your tutor at the Merényi site at the time given by the tutor
- You must get the **attendance sheet** signed by the tutor. After the tutor's **signature and stamp**, submit the attendance sheet in the designated binder/box at the Triage desk.
- The completion of the practice will only be recorded in the Neptun system after both the attendance sheet and the key have been submitted, and the traumatology exam has been completed.
