Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 2nd semester of the 2023/2024 academic year

Department: Traumatology

Faculty: Medicine

Our feedback on general comments by the students:

The Traumatology Clinic received 19 completed student questionnaires (19.19%) from the English language students in the 2st semester of the 2023/2024 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system concerning feedback of the subject and 3 incomplete questionnaires (3.03%). All of the feedback was in conjunction with the faculty average, except in three cases:

- “To what extent did the educational work of the institute arouse your interest in the subject?”

Clinic for Traumatology received a 4.32 compared to the average of 4.53 of the faculty.

- “How useful, thought-provoking, and interactive were the exercises?”

Clinic for Traumatology received a 4.26 compared to the average of 4.52 of the faculty.

- „All in all, how do you rate the teaching of the subject?”

Clinic for Traumatology received a 4.26 compared to the average of 4.53 of the faculty.

The Clinic for Traumatology received the following comments from English

language students in the 2st semester of the 2023/2024 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system concerning the general comments by the students:

- “Have the end presentation to be graded and influence the final grade”
The presentation part of the exam is graded as “passed” or “failed”, so it can not influence the final grade. It is a must have to let students to final exam.
- “More trauma related cases and not just orthopedics, as we will have an orthopedic block later.”
From this semester, we finally have the separated Clinic for Traumatology, what organizes the lectures. At the department we mainly take care of trauma patient, so from now on we can present more trauma cases to the students.

In regards to the special questionnaire pertaining feedback on the block schedule, the Clinic for Traumatology received 19 completed student questionnaires (19.19%) from the English language students in the 2st semester of the 2023/2024 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system and 3 incomplete questionnaires (3.03%).

The feedback was lower than the average of the faculty in every cases.

- From the 1st of November 2023 the separate Trauma Clinic was established, so from now on we can emphasis on trauma patients and cases, so we can educate the students about traumatology in more focused way.

The Trauma Clinic did not receive any student comments concerning feedback of the block schedule from English language students in the 2st semester of the 2023/2024 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system.
