Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year

Department: Traumatology

Faculty: Medicine

Our feedback on general comments by the students:

The Traumatology Department received 30 completed student questionnaires (38.46%) from the English language students in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system concerning feedback of the subject and 8 incomplete questionnaires (10.26%). All of the feedback was in conjunction with the faculty average, except in one case:

"All in all, how do you rate the teaching of the subject?
Department of Traumatology received a 4.70 compared to the average of 4.49 of the faculty. (0.21 point higher, than the average)

The Traumatology Department received the following comments from English language students in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system concerning the general comments by the students:

- "I think the weeks spent in classes do not accurately prepare us for the exam and knowledge we are expected to have. On the other hand, the practices were nice and interactive and well organized"
  - Our clinic has its own schedule for each practical day, so all students are taught in the same way. It's not easy to teach them every aspect of traumatology, but the recommended books cover the exam material.







- "The first day of traumatology was a bit tiring with all the lectures, spliting the theoretical teaching in 2 days would be easier"
  - We have just updated and shortened it so we can fit all the information within the lecture time. We are considering splitting the theoretical part into two days.

In regards to the special questionnaire pertaining feedback on the block schedule, the Traumatology Department received 29 completed student questionnaires (37,18%) from the English language students in the 1st semester of the 2024/2025 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system and 9 incomplete questionnaires (11,54%).

All the feedback was at the average of the faculty except in one case:

"Organization on block-based education"

Department of Traumatology received a 4.43 compared to the average of 4.69 of the faculty. (0.06 point lower, than the average)

The Department of Traumatology received the following comment from English language students in the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system:

- "Make back up days for when there are holidays or videos for lectures".
  - We believe, that face-to-face interaction is the most effective way to teach, so we are not planning to make videos of the lectures. Our clinic provides back up days almost every week.
- "Wish the exam was by the end of the ortho week and not in a separate week"
  - o we believe that it's better for the students to have a couple of days before the exam, so they can perform better.
