## Action plan based on the student feedback received in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year

Department: Traumatology

Faculty: Medicine

Our feedback on general comments by the students:

The Traumatology Department received 43 completed student questionnaires (48.31%) from the English language students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system concerning feedback of the subject and 10 incomplete questionnaires (11.24%). All of the feedback was in conjunction with the faculty average, except in one case:

"How useful, dynamic, and logical were the presentations?"
 Department of Traumatology received a 4.26 compared to the average of 4.49 of the faculty. (0.23 point lower, than the average)

The Traumatology Department received the following comments from English language students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system concerning the general comments by the students:

- . "We didn't have most of the lecture slides for ortho lectures"
  - o All slides of the traumatology subject are uploaded to Moodle.
- "For hospitals outside of Semmelweis a specific schedule could be effective. I felt like an orphan without the class schedule"
  - At our department we do have a schedule, so we could standardize the education. We encourage the other hospitals to do the same.
- "The traumatology part of the block was well organised. I enjoyed the way







the ortho was explained and taught, however the disorganisation was frustrating as sometimes lecturers could not show up because the had surgeries which is not ideal"

- We are responsible for the traumatology subject, but we encourage ortopedic collages to have a schedule for every day.
- "It needs more structure, better teaching material"
  - We updated our schedule to be able to work in a more organized manner.

In regards to the special questionnaire pertaining feedback on the block schedule, the Traumatology Department received 45 completed student questionnaires (50,56%) from the English language students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the 2024/2025 academic year through Neptun Unipoll system and 8 incomplete questionnaires (8,99%). Most of the feedback was at the average of the faculty except four cases:

· "Organization on block-based education"

Department of Traumatology received a 4.47 compared to the average of 4.76 of the faculty.

"Structure of the topic"

Department of Traumatology received a 4.37 compared to the average of 4.74 of the faculty.

- To what extent did the taught material help you prepare for the exam?
  Department of Traumatology received a 4.21 compared to the average of 4.72 of the faculty.
- Overall, how would you rate the block-based teaching of the subject?
  Department of Traumatology received a 4.37 compared to the average of 4.76 of the faculty.
