Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("implementation review"):

Overall, there was a substantial improvement in students' feedback from the last semester. Therefore, we do not plan to make any changes to the basic structure or main characteristics of the block.

- The OSCE examination system has been introduced, and the OSCE examination scenarios have been further developed based on student feedback.
- As a new initiative, small-group POCUS sessions will be introduced to further develop students' practical and hands-on skills.
- The integration of Artificial Intelligence (AI) into teaching is also planned.

Our feedback on general comments by the students:

- Based on current feedback, no major changes are needed in the structure of the schedule or the length of breaks.
- Alongside the continuous development of the OSCE examination system, we plan to place increased emphasis on ensuring opportunities for practice.

Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:

- Based on individual feedback regarding the practical sessions, students evaluated the rotation very positively overall; therefore, we do not plan any major modifications.
